Modifying the Date Format Printed on Linux Portraits and Sketches

You can format the date printed at the bottom of the drawings created on Linux machines. To format the date, follow these steps:

1. Press **Q** key to exit the rotation. The system displays the Booth Menu.
2. Press the **Alt+F2** keys. The system prompts you to enter your username.
3. Type **vend** at the username prompt and press the **Enter** key. The system prompts you for your password.
4. Type **fotofant** at the password prompt and press the **Enter** key. The system displays the system prompt.

5. Type the following command and press the **Enter** key:

```
mcedit studio/rotation.ini
```

The system starts the mcedit editor and displays the file rotation.ini.

6. Press the **Page Down** key to go to the end of the file.
7. Press the **Enter** key to start a new line.
8. Type one of the following commands:
 - In the United States type:
DateFormat=%m/%d/%y
 - In other areas type:
DateFormat=%d/%m/%y
9. Press the **F10** to save and exit. The system displays the Quit dialog box.
10. Press the **Tab** key to select **Yes**.
11. Press the **Enter** key to save the file and exit.
12. Type **reboot** and press the **Enter** key to reboot the system and return to the rotation screens.
13. Test the system by printing a sketch to verify the dates are correct.
