Setting a Linux Operating System Booth to Freevend

These directions describe how to set a Linux booth to freevend.

Note: Linux is case specific, for example, ADAM is NOT the same as Adam is NOT the same as adam.

Upgrade Parts List

This upgrade includes the following parts:

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To change a booth from vend mode to freevend mode, follow these steps:

1. Press the **Q** key to quit the Ad Rotation.
2. Press and hold the **CTRL** and **ALT** keys then press and release the **F4** key. Release all keys. The system displays the following login prompt:
3. Type **vend** at the login prompt and press the **Enter** key.
4. Type fotofant at the password prompt and press the **Enter** key. The system displays the following messages:

```

5. Type **cd sys** and press the **Enter** key.
6. Type **mcedit CONFIG** and press the **Enter** key.
7. Use the arrow keys to position the cursor after the **equals (=)** sign in the line **VENDAPP=freevend**.
8. Type the word free. Now the line looks like:
VENDAPP=freevend
9. Press the **F10** key. The system prompts you:
Save and Exit?
10. Type **yes** and press the **Enter** key.
11. Type **cd /vend/bin**.
12. Type **mcedit freevend**. The displays the following message:
#!/bin/sh
exec /vend/bin/.....
13. Use the arrow key to position the cursor at the end of the following line:

#!/bin/sh

14. Press the **Enter** key and type the following lines:

MAX_FREE_PRINTS=999

export MAX_FREE_PRINTS

Now the file looks like the following lines:

#!/bin/sh

MAX_FREE_PRINTS=999

export MAX_FREE_PRINTS

exec /vend/bin/.....

15. Press the **F10** key. The system prompts you:

Save and Exit?

16. Type **yes** and press the **Enter** key.

17. Type **reboot**. The system reboots and is now in freevend mode.
